# Good Practice - SDG Nr. 10

## UKs government approach to reducing inequalities

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the Global Goals, were adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity. Goal number 10 relates to reduce inequality within and among countries. In total this goal has ten different targets to achieve until the year 2030. Below one good practice related to this.

### Social Goals

By centrally investing in SDG 10 - Reducing inequalities, the UK government is actively promoting several initiatives and schemes which can be implemented by local and regional authorities. Key social goals are the following:

- Reducing crime
- Tackle illegal migration
- Reduce re-offending
- Allow for better legitimate movement of people and goods to promote economic prosperity, to mention a few.

This enforces and promotes a more cohesive and resilient community allowing for social injustices to decrease.

### What need does it cover?

Each initiative targets a separate need of the community and citizens. One very interesting need covered is the support provided to everyone who wish to start their own business.



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| <b>How was it founded?</b>        | Centrally through the government with local and regional authorities promoting all initiatives and funding schemes. Moreover, information campaign are available to all interested parties through various channels.   |
| <b>How does it relate to SDGs</b> | It directly relates to SDG 10 since inequalities are targeted and citizens have access to information, knowledge, support and resources to move freely around the country, live respectfully and with safety, promote and sustain new businesses, all in a country promoting human rights, values and democracy. |
| <b>Good practices</b>             | Seminars and training to upgrade the skillsets of respective professionals in the different departments who reinforce SDG goals. One example is the trianing of the stafe in the Home Office.  |
