The hotels for insects

Learning Objectives

- Identify who you are targeting with this initiative in the local community
- Set up cooperation with the local community and local authorities
- Set up an information campaign and target to increase knowledge on halt biodiversity loss.

Description

In order to preserve biodiversity and the balance in nature, hotels (houses) for insects can be built and installed on trees in the city or on the roofs of office buildings. In the summer, the houses allow insects to stay and shelter, and in the fall, a place to spend the winter.

This micro-project aims to build environmental awareness among residents and employees. Its goal is to build biodiversity in urban space. These types of places for insects help them survive and extend the species. This has a positive effect on the local environment and shaping biodiversity in specific locations.

Possible roles of the trainees and skills needed

- To motivate people to take part in this microproject.
- To facilitate the process of the implementation this microproject.
- To discuss and allocate roles with the people involved in the microproject implementation.
- The skills needed: problem solving, team work, creativity.



Theoretical activity	Gathering all information on the materials used to create hotels for insects or purchase of ready-made boxes (boxes) for an insect hotel. Selection of places where insect hotels will be placed, obtaining permits.
Creative activity	This Initiative may be accompanied by an environmental education program not only of the society but also of employees to inform them about the course of the entire initiative, shaping biodiversity in specific locations, and a positive impact on the natural environment.

Sustainability

The implementation costs of this micro-project are small, so this initiative can be continued each year by groups of residents or groups of employees.
